The minimum age for helpers is 16 years old. Helpers over 18 years old must hold DBS (formerly CRB) clearance and <u>ALL</u> helpers must complete the Catholic Church safer recruitment process. There is no charge for DBS approvals, which must have been issued within the last 3 years. Forms are available from the Diocesan Safeguarding Office on 0151 652 9855. If you have received any cautions, warnings or convictions please discuss these in strict confidence with Andrew O'Brien, Diocesan Safeguarding Co-ordinator, on the above number before submitting your booking form. Having a criminal record will not necessarily bar you from work. To allow time to process these applications we cannot accept applications from volunteers after **30th APRIL 2024**.

It is a legal requirement that all helpers must receive training from a qualified health professional organised through the pilgrimage. The Pilgrimage Nursing Team provides a number of training sessions prior to the departure of the pilgrimage. Attendance at one of these sessions is **compulsory** if you wish to offer your services as a helper. The pilgrimage management team always strives to improve the care and safety of all pilgrims travelling to Lourdes. The pilgrimage care team have a collective experience of looking after people with different needs. If you require assistance at home with your mobility and/or daily activities from family members or carers and are planning to travel to Lourdes without these support mechanisms, you should stay in the Accueil. All pilgrims requiring assistance with medical, nursing and care needs who book to stay in the Accueil will be assessed by the senior care team prior to the pilgrimage.

The Pilgrimage Medical team is allowed under French law to treat only registered sick pilgrims staying in the Accueil. It is not possible therefore to provide medical and nursing care for those staying in hotels, who will need to use the services of French doctors.

Should you need to take your own special chair you must insure it privately as it will not be covered by your standard travel insurance. Please make sure all detachable parts are individually and clearly marked with your name, address and hotel. If you bring your own wheelchair for use at Liverpool John Lennon Airport we have arranged secure storage until your return.
